QUALIFICATIONS:

- Current Washington State Registered Nurse license required.
- Successful experience as a Registered Nurse required. (Pediatric experience preferred)
- Must possess the ability to monitor compliance of measures that protect students/others in accordance with state, federal and local health department regulations, i.e. immunizations, mandatory reporting, communicable diseases, etc.
- Must maintain confidentiality in compliance with state/federal/school district policies.
- Must be willing to provide a wide range of nursing care tasks in a school setting. May include one on one care.
